Brecon Buzz CIC (registered company no. 13161362) is the managing body for Brecon Choir Festival. Brecon Buzz CIC recognises the importance of safeguarding the personal data of our audience and supporters. We hold contact information as provided by those individuals who sign up to and register their interest in Brecon Buzz and Brecon Choir Festival.

This includes names, addresses, email addresses and telephone numbers. We hold this information so that we can communicate with you about Brecon Choir Festival, related events and news.

We don't sell or pass personal data on to other organisations or companies. If other local Festivals want to communicate with Brecon Choir Festival supporters, they can only do so via Brecon Buzz, not directly.

We may store the email contact information you consent to us holding in a system owned by a third party, specifically Mailchimp. This enables us to send information to those who have signed up for newsletters and / or bought tickets. Mailchimp is a GDPR compliant organisation and has its own privacy policy and terms that can be seen at <https://mailchimp.com/legal/>.

RETENTION:

In accordance with data protection laws and good commercial practice, we do not retain data in a form that permits identification of the person(s) to whom it relates for any longer than is necessary. Once the purpose for which information has been collected has been fulfilled, we will either permanently delete your personal information or remove all identifiers within it so that it is no longer personal data. We may use such anonymised data for research and/or business analysis purposes.

Where you have signed up to our mailing list, we will retain your details for as long as you remain on that list. If you unsubscribe, we will remove your details from the list.

Where we obtain your personal data in relation to the use or purchase of our services or products, including VAT or invoicing information, we are obligated by law to keep this for a minimum of 6 years.
